Overview

California Polytechnic State University ranks 154 in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings with a score of 56, an F speech climate grade. The university retains a “yellow light” Spotlight rating and lacks commitments to the Chicago Statement or institutional neutrality.

Cal Poly places in the bottom 25 for “Comfort Expressing Ideas.” Even more striking, the school’s “Self-Censorship” rank plunged from the top 50 last year to the bottom 50 this year.

Cal Poly could improve by revising its written policies to earn a “green light” Spotlight rating, as well as adopting the Chicago Statement and an official commitment to institutional neutrality.

FIRE’s Spotlight database annually rates regulations on student expression based on the extent to which they restrict free speech.

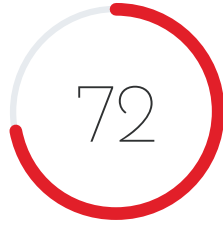
