## Overview

University of California, Irvine ranks 164 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings. Its score stands at 56 with an F speech climate grade.

UCI places in the bottom 50 for both “Comfort Expressing Ideas” and “Administrative Support,” underscoring persistent concerns about the campus dialogue. No survey area lands in the top 50, and the school still earns a “yellow light” Spotlight rating with no official adoption of the Chicago Statement or a statement on institutional neutrality.

UCI could improve by revising its written speech policies to earn a “green light” Spotlight rating, adopting a free speech statement based on the Chicago Statement, and adopting an official commitment to institutional neutrality.

FIRE’s Spotlight database annually rates regulations on student expression based on the extent to which they restrict free speech.

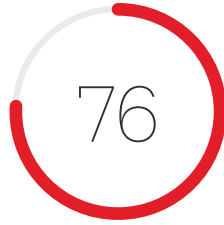
