Overview

University of Colorado Boulder ranks 5 in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings with a score of 74, earning a C speech climate grade. The climb from the prior year's rank coincides with the university's new statement on institutional neutrality, which complements its longstanding "green light" Spotlight rating and the University of Colorado System's adoption of the Chicago Statement, which applies to the Boulder campus.

Policy commitments aside, student perceptions are above average but not stellar in any area. Maintaining its top-tier overall rank will require translating strong written policies into everyday campus culture.
