## Overview

Emory University ranks 67 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings with a score of 61, rebounding 87 places and lifting its overall grade to a D-. The rise coincided with reduced penalties for free speech controversies in prior years.

Policy-wise, Emory earns a “green light” Spotlight rating, yet student perceptions remain bleak. The university places in the bottom 25 for both “Comfort Expressing Ideas” and “Administrative Support,” and in the bottom 50 for “Self-Censorship.”

Emory could build on its policy strength by publicly adopting the Chicago Statement and an official commitment to institutional neutrality.

FIRE's Spotlight database annually rates regulations on student expression based on the extent to which they restrict free speech.

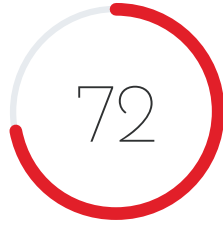
