## Overview

Montclair State University ranks 202 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings. The university posts a score of 54 and earns an F speech climate grade.

Students feel relatively at ease sharing views on campus, placing Montclair State in the top 50 for “Comfort Expressing Ideas.” That bright spot is overshadowed by a persistent weakness: the university lands in the bottom 25 nationwide for “Political Tolerance,” signaling reluctance to welcome speakers with controversial views.

Montclair State could improve by revising its written speech policies to earn a “green light” Spotlight rating, adopting a free speech statement based on the Chicago Statement, and adopting an official commitment to institutional neutrality.
