Overview

The University of Oklahoma ranks 93 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings with a score of 59. The university continues to earn a “yellow light” Spotlight rating but has adopted the Chicago Statement.

Student perceptions put OU in the top 50 for perceived “Administrative Support,” but the campus ranks in the bottom 25 for both “Self-Censorship” and “Openness” and in the bottom 50 for attitudes toward “Disruptive Conduct.” Those results suggest many students hesitate to voice unpopular views while a sizable share remains comfortable with shout-downs.

OU could regain ground by revising its remaining restrictive policies to earn a “green light” Spotlight rating and adopting an official commitment to institutional neutrality.
