## Overview

Utah Valley University ranks 71 out of 257 schools in the 2026 College Free Speech Rankings. The university earned a score of 61, a D- speech climate grade, and it earns a “yellow light” Spotlight rating with no adoption of the Chicago Statement or the Kalven Report.

Student perceptions paint a mixed picture of campus expression. UVU ranks 1 in “Disruptive Conduct,” indicating that more students find shouting down or violence unacceptable than other schools. The school places in the top 25 for “Comfort Expressing Ideas” and in the top 50 for “Political Tolerance” and “Administrative Support.” Despite these bright spots, the overall grade remains low, reflecting restrictive written policies and the absence of formal free-speech commitments.

UVU could improve quickly by revising its speech codes to earn a “green light” Spotlight rating and formally adopting the Chicago Statement and an official commitment to institutional neutrality – signaling stronger institutional support for open expression.
