Overview

Claremont McKenna College ranks 2 out of 261 schools in the 2027 College Free Speech Rankings with a score of 80 and a B- speech climate grade. CMC has adopted the pro-free speech Chicago Statement and an official commitment to institutional neutrality, and it earns a “green light” Spotlight rating.

CMC ranks in the top 25 for “Comfort Expressing Ideas” and “Administrative Support,” indicating students feel comfortable sharing views on controversial topics and trust the administration to defend free speech. It also ranks in the top 25 for “Openness,” indicating fewer topics feel off-limits. The data shows no bottom 50 weaknesses.

CMC should respond clearly and forcefully to defend free speech whenever censorship occurs or is demanded. Doing so will demonstrate the college’s commitment to free speech and build community trust that the administration will defend expressive rights.
