Overview

University of Colorado Boulder ranks 23 out of 261 schools in the 2027 College Free Speech Rankings with a score of 73 and a C speech climate grade.

While the data shows no top 50 strengths or bottom 50 weaknesses, the university's rank for "Disruptive Conduct" tumbled 105 places from last year, showing increasing student acceptance of non-peaceful forms of protest.

The campus earns a "green light" Spotlight rating. CU Boulder has adopted a statement on institutional neutrality and is part of the University of Colorado System, which has affirmed the pro-free speech Chicago Statement. CU Boulder should respond clearly and forcefully to defend free speech whenever censorship occurs or is demanded. Doing so will demonstrate the university's commitment to free speech and build community trust that the administration will defend expressive rights.

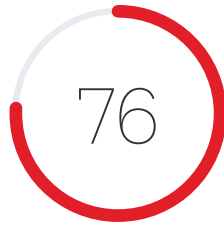
